



Northern Utah Human Resource Association Awarded For Elevating Human Resources, Improving Workplaces

Layton, UT, April 24, 2024 — SHRM recently awarded the Northern Utah Human Resource Association (NUHRA) its prestigious EXCEL Platinum Award for the chapter’s accomplishments in 2023.

The EXCEL award is given to state councils and chapters to recognize major accomplishments, strategic activities, and tactical initiatives that elevate the profession of human resources.

The EXCEL Award can be earned at four levels: bronze, silver, gold, and platinum. Each level has a prescribed set of requirements and accomplishments that must be met. NUHRA will receive recognition in SHRM publications and at conferences, a logo to display on its website, and information to share with its members about the significance of this award.

In order to achieve this award, NUHRA dedicated its time and resources to several initiatives. First and foremost, NUHRA’s members were considered. NUHRA conducted surveys and made efforts to make sure membership was of value to its members. The chapter started offering quarterly Ask-An-Attorney events where members could ask questions and hear legal updates in real time. Each year, the chapter holds a golf tournament to raise funds for scholarships for local HR students, and for the first time, this year, NUHRA extended this to offering scholarships for master’s degrees. The chapter plans to continue the practice of helping to develop its members and future members. The chapter also held initiatives in the areas of diversity and inclusion, certification, and also made efforts to support the SHRM Foundation.
