NUHRA's Pinnacle Award

For the second time, the Northern Utah Human Resource Association has been awarded SHRM's highest honor, the Pinnacle Award, for Advancing the HR Profession.

According to SHRM, "The SHRM Pinnacle Award Program is an annual recognition program honoring the highest achievements in affiliate development and contributions that serve HR professionals, advance the HR profession and enhance the SHRM community. SHRM chapters and state councils are encouraged to apply for a Pinnacle Award for innovative projects created and implemented by your SHRM affiliate."

The first award was received in November 2014 for our continuous efforts at providing scholarships to HR students. We have had decades of success with this program and are committed to continue to support the future of our profession.

In November 2024, we were once again awarded a Pinnacle, this time in conjunction with Salt Lake SHRM and the Utah Human Resources State Council (Utah SHRM).

As you know, our very own Michael Stagner spearheaded the effort to provide Utah HR professionals with help and solutions to a common problem. It wasn't until we banded together with Salt Lake and Utah SHRM to involve the whole state that we saw results.
