Dual Membership

Hopefully by now you've heard that NUHRA is moving into a dual membership relationship with SHRM. For years we have been a 100% chapter. In fact, we're part of a 100% state, which means that in Utah, to join a SHRM chapter, you first must be a member of SHRM national.

In the past, you paid for your SHRM membership on the anniversary of the date you joined. Then you paid your NUHRA dues each January for a calendar year membership. Now, things will be different.

Beginning July of 2021, NUHRA and National SHRM are partnering together to bring our members dual membership!

Here is what this means for you:

- All memberships will be purchased in one transaction through National SHRM at www.shrm.org.
- You no longer need to worry about maintaining two memberships, as they will be paired together.
- Your national and local SHRM memberships will have the same expiration dates moving forward.
- All membership costs will remain the same.

We understand there are going to be lots of questions, and we are going to work through them. For example, in the first year we may need to balance bill or refund people to get their SHRM and NUHRA expiration dates to match. We have a plan and will reach out to people as needed. Feel free to ask questions if you have them.
